

THERE IS NO PLACE LIKE HOME

Riverside dock – Lungotevere San Paolo, 48 – Rome

For its fourth edition, **THERE IS NO PLACE LIKE HOME** invites **30 artists** to an unusual and little known location of the capital: a dock on the **river Tiber** in the vicinity of **Ponte Marconi**. The area, ordinarily inaccessible to the public, will be home to a series of performances and works of art displayed within an old fishing boat, moored along the dock for this very occasion.

The exhibition, which presents installations, video-projections and performances, will be **inaugurated Friday 16th September 2016 from 16:00 to 23:00** and will last **until 30th September 2016**.

The exhibition offers a new insight into Rome, a view from its guts: the restless grey-water of the Tiber. Contemporary art breathes new life into the river which courses through the city, where its aspects of nature and navigation are still preserved.

From the urban landscape of Lungotevere San Paolo we step through number 48 making our way along a dirt track which leads us to the dock, between the pillars of Ponte Guglielmo Marconi and the rushes of the fluvial landscape. Displayed inside the boat, surrounded by vegetation the artist's works undulate. Over fifteen days the visitors will be able to explore the bankside and venture on board.

THERE IS NO PLACE LIKE HOME is a contemporary art project conceived in Rome in 2014 from an initiative of a group of artists (**Giuseppe Pietroniro, Stanislao Di Giugno, Marco Raparelli, Alessandro Cicoria, Daniele Puppi**) and two art historians (**Giuliana Benassi and Giulia Lopalco**) whose objective is to create a dialogue between art and the city by installing exhibitions within spaces which are not usually dedicated to culture, and which acquire a new value through the artist's work.

The artist's performances will take place from 16th to 19th and 28th September 2016.

The fourth edition of **THERE IS NO PLACE LIKE HOME** has been realized with the contribution of Roma Capitale, in collaboration with SIAE. This event is included in the 2016 edition of ESTATE ROMANA: "Rome, a Cultural Capital", with the patronage of the River Tiber Authorities.
